## **CALL FOR PAPERS: DEADLINE 4 MARCH 2005**

On behalf of the organisers, I am writing to invite you to attend the First European Summer Symposium in Behavioural Economics of the RTN Project "European Network for the Advancement of Behavioural Economics", partly-funded through the Marie Curie Actions of the European Commission's Sixth Framework Programme. It is also being financed further through the generous support of the Russell Sage Foundation and will take place at IDEI, Toulouse on 20-21 June 2005.

The two-day conference aims to bring together economists and psychologists working on topics including:

- Identity (broadly defined to include group/social identity and self perception),
- Moral sentiments (with applications to, for example, fairness, civic behaviour and intrinsic motivation),
- Cognition, emotions and decision-making (with applications to markets and organisations).

Travel expenses incurred by members of teams participating in the RTN will need to be covered from their own project networking budget. Expenses for other invited participants will be covered according to the new CEPR travel guidelines, details of which will be provided for successful applicants. Please indicate on your reply form whether you will be able to cover your own travel costs, or whether you will require funding from CEPR.

Individuals from within the RTN (University of Amsterdam, CEPR, University of Zurich, Stockholm School of Economics, IDEI, University of Munich, University of Mannheim, Harvard University and Princeton University) and from the research community in general are invited to submit a paper.

We would, at this stage, like you to simply confirm your interest in presenting or discussing a paper. Please do this by completing the enclosed reply form, indicating whether or not you wish to present a paper, or would be willing to act as a discussant, and returning it to psycon@cict.fr by **Friday**, **4**<sup>th</sup> **March 2005**. If you would like to present a paper please include it in your response. We will confirm your participation in April 2005.
